
FORT FREEDOM COVID PROTOCOL - CLIENTS

Prior to admission, the following questions are asked to ensure we are not inadvertently inviting a potentially exposed person into our facility.

1. Have you been diagnosed with Coronavirus?
2. Have you traveled to China, Italy, or Iran within the last 30 days?
3. Are you currently experiencing symptoms of runny nose, sore throat, cough, fever, or difficulty breathing?
4. Have you been exposed to anyone experiencing symptoms listed above within the last 30 days?
5. Have you been exposed to anyone who has been diagnosed with Coronavirus within the last 30 days?
6. Have you traveled outside of the country within the last 30 days?
7. Have you experienced a loss or decreased sense of smell or taste?

If a potential admission answers yes to any of the above questions, state, airline, and local travel restrictions and quarantine regulations will apply. These regulations must be adhered to prior to admission.

Program participants will always practice social distancing. In addition, proper handwashing and sanitization techniques will be enforced. Failure to abide by these guidelines will be grounds for dismissal from the program.

It is required that when social distancing is not attainable inside or outside of the facility, program participants will wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth. These masks will be provided by Fort Freedom if the Veteran as needed.

Program participants may also be subject to a thermal, no-touch, temporal thermometer reading twice per day. Should any temperature reading exceed 101°F, the following process will be followed.

- Veteran will be provided a mask to wear until test results are received.
- Veteran will be transported to the local Urgent Care facility to be tested.
- Negative test result:
 - Veteran will be taken to local pharmacy to pick up any prescriptions needed.
 - Veteran will be transported back to Fort Freedom's facility and be required to quarantine at the facility until recommendations by doctor have been met and/or a 72-hour period.
 - Confidential Covid-19 Incident Report will be completed.
- Positive test result:
 - Veteran will be taken to local pharmacy to pick up any prescriptions needed.
 - Veteran will be taken to quarantine location near facility for at least 5 days.

- Two negative test results must be received prior to re-admission in the program.
- Meals will be provided daily via delivery service to the quarantine location.
- Communication between Veteran and Program Director will be required at least twice daily.
- All services will be provided remotely at the regularly scheduled times.
- Confidential Covid-19 Incident Report will be completed.
