

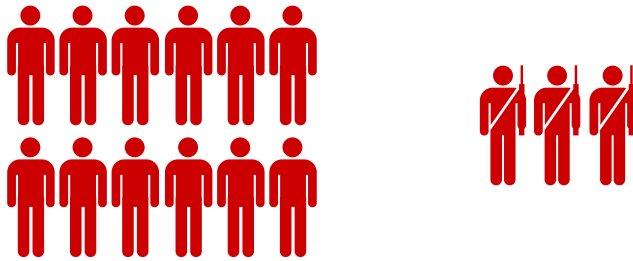


ANNUAL REPORT 2021

**OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS THIS YEAR ARE:**

- ★ Laid the groundwork of perfecting our program, including finalizing the website, social media platforms, marketing materials, and internal software.
- ★ Introduced a condensed 14-day programs for veterans who need help now.
- ★ Hired support staff to grow the team and focus our efforts.
- ★ Recruited a diverse Board of Directors to advance the mission.
- ★ Treated five veterans despite setbacks from the COVID pandemic.
- ★ Partnered with MedTechVets to provide a six-week course to our veterans for job placement after they complete the program.
- ★ Hosted our Inaugural Veterans Day Celebration raising over \$500,000 for our mission.
- ★ Launched our \$17 a month campaign, in honor of the 17 veterans who commit suicide each day in the United States.
